INDOOR SPACES

Parish Hall

capacity 70

A 100' by 40' high hall surrounded by stained glass windows with a raised proscenium stage and balcony. Folding tables and chairs for meals and meetings or completely bare for activities.



Guild Room

 capacity 40

An elegant paneled and carpeted room with long table and comfortable chairs for meetings.



Undercroft

 capacity 50

Multi-use Meeting Room.

Kitchen (prepared food only)

Large kitchen with refrigerator, range, oven, freezer, icemaker, industrial dishwasher, food prep island and easy access to the Guild Room, Parish Hall and the outside.

OUTDOOR SPACES

Great Lawn

A 2 acre expanse of gently sloped grass with easy access to power and street. Also easily controlled access points. Tents may be erected.

Cloister

An intimate, completely enclosed courtyard with grass center and surrounding raised and roofed walkway with direct access to the Parish Hall.

There is a covered stage-like area suitable for a music ensemble or other equipment that must be shielded from weather.

Parking

Considerable parking on the adjacent roads and a large lot (100 cars) next door.

Access to Long Island Sound, Glen Cove, Bayville, and Locust Valley.

Public beaches are less than a mile away as are towns with restaurants and shopping.
